

# Let's Play Scrabble!

- A teaching tool that meets several formal assessment requirements of the Australian National Curriculum.
- Teachers say children love and are fully engaged by Let's Play Scrabble.
- Teachers need not be Scrabble players. The program covers multiple lessons and exercises which need little or no additional preparation.
- Adapted from the adult game by qualified teachers for Year 5-6 primary school children the program has also proven valuable for younger children and at high schools for English as a Second Language and Remedial English.
- Mental arithmetic, mental agility, and strategic thinking skills are developed.
- Spelling and interest in words are improved and vocabulary developed.
- Let's Play Scrabble exercises can be adapted for use in any subject or class period.
- The program uses a modified board and fewer tiles. A full class can complete a whole game during one period.
- Children play in pairs, developing teamwork and social interaction skills.
